MAJOR LANE SHIFTS ON NEW YORK AVENUE BEGINNING MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2009

As DC Department of Transportation (DDOT) continues work on the 9th Street Bridge over New York Ave, lane shifts will be implemented on Monday September 28, 2009. The Traffic will be shifted in both directions West Bound and East Bound.

The three (3) New York Avenue West Bound lanes will shift left and be reduced from 11' feet wide to 10' wide beginning at Fairview Ave and shift back to the right at just past the 9th St Bridge.

The three (3) new York Avenue East Bound lanes will shift right and reduce from 11' feet wide to 10' feet wide beginning just before 9th St Bridge and back to the left at Fairview Ave.

Throughout this phase of work there will be interruption to the traffic flow by this construction activity using intermittent single lane closures on New York Ave in both directions during the off peak travel hours.

DDOT will maintain all three (3) lanes of traffic East bound from 3:30 PM to 7:00 PM and 3 lanes of traffic west bound from 6:30 AM to 9:30 AM.

DDOT encourages all motorists to stay alert as they travel through this busy work zone
